Michigan NENA's 2012 Annual Conference will be May 20-23, 2012 and will be held in Lansing, MI. This 'Call for Papers' invites industry associates and professionals to submit a written proposal to be added to the conference educational track.

Important Conference Dates:

Pre-Conference Training Day: Sunday, May 20, 2012

First Full Day of Conference: Monday, May 21, 2012 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Second Full Day of Conference: Tuesday, May, 22, 2012 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Last Full Day of Conference: Wednesday, May 23, 2012 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Submission Timeline:

Submissions will be accepted through February 17, 2012

Submissions will be accepted and speakers notified by April 16, 2012

Notification of Date and Time of sessions will be emailed to speaker separately.

Presentations should be 50-55 minutes in length

Presentations should be educational in nature and not a sales tool. They should be topics of interest and usefulness to the public safety field. They can be lessons learned, examples of successful implementations/operations, introductions of new technologies, problem-solving, operations, ways to improve operations, etc.

Submittals shall include:

1. Biography of the presenter - ***short*** bio also to be used for introductions
2. Title of Presentation
3. Brief Description of presentation - 25 words or less
4. The learning objectives being taught to attendees

There is no limit on the number of presentations that can be submitted. Presentations requiring more time than the 50-55 minute length, can be scheduled in two or three consecutive sessions.

Remuneration: Each speaker receives one complimentary full conference registration. No other remuneration will be given.

Presenters will be required to sign a Speaker Agreement form and Audio/Visual form
